The changes must identify the minimum number of credit hours for a program, must coordinate with industry stakeholders and enable experts in trade and industry to become CTE teachers through limited licenses or alternative requirements for licensure (CTE licenses).</p> <p>In addition, the Commission redesigned teaching licenses on January 1, 2016.
