## **CTE License Redesign**

HB 3072 requires ODE and TSPC to review CTE licensure and program rules to make any necessary changes. The changes must identify the minimum number of credit hours for a program, must coordinate with industry stakeholders and enable experts in trade and industry to become CTE teachers through limited licenses or alternative requirements for licensure (CTE licenses).

In addition, the Commission redesigned teaching licenses on January 1, 2016. To align with the new teaching licenses, the CTE licenses will be redesigned as well.
