The Notice was sent via U.S. First 11 Class Mail and U.S. Certified Mail Receipt 7018 1830 0001 6178 6339 to the address on file 12 with the Commission. The Notice designated the Commission file as the record for purposes 13 of proving a prima facie case. The Certified Mail receipt was returned to the Commission 14 "Unable to forward". The first class mail was not returned to the Commission and assumed 15 delivered. The Notice of Opportunity of Hearing, dated August 28, 2019, and signed by 16 Anthony Rosilez, Executive Director, stated: 17 "IF A REQUEST FOR HEARING IS NOT RECEIVED WITHIN THIS 21-DAY 18 PERIOD, YOUR RIGHT TO A HEARING SHALL BE CONSIDERED WAIVED 19 UNLESS YOUR FAILURE TO REQUEST A HEARING WAS BEYOND YOUR 20 REASONABLE CONTROL. IF YOU DO NOT REQUEST A HEARING, WITHDRAW 21 YOUR REQUEST FOR HEARING, IF YOU FAIL TO APPEAR AT A HEARING, OR 22 NOTIFY THE COMMISSION THAT YOU WILL NOT APPEAR AT HEARING, THE 23 COMMISSION WILL ADOPT AN ORDER OF DEFAULT WHICH MAY INCLUDE 24 THE REVOCATION OR SUSPENSION OF YOUR LICENSE OR OTHER 25 DISCIPLINE." 26 27 Campbell did not request a hearing. The Commission, therefore, finds Campbell to be in 28 default and enters the following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and final order, based 29 on the files and records of the Commission concerning this matter. 30 FINDINGS OF FACT 31 1. Campbell has been licensed by the Commission since September 1, 2015. 32 Campbell holds a Preliminary School Psychologist License, with an endorsement 33 in School Psychologist (PK-12), valid from March 2, 2017, through March 31, 34 2020. During all relevant times, Campbell was employed by the Bethel School 35 District (BSD). 36 2. On September 7, 2018, the Commission was notified by the BSD that Campbell 37

may have violated professional standards by failing to provide 60 days' notice of

1	resignation as required by contract and state law ORS 342.553(1). Subsequent
2	investigation determined the following:
3	a. On June 14, 2018, Campbell entered into an employment contract with
4	BSD, accepting her probationary teaching contract for the 2018-2019
5	school year. On August 13, 2018, Campbell submitted her resignation to
6	BSD, effective immediately. On August 14, 2018, Campbell was advised of
7	the requirement to provide 60 days' notice as detailed in state law.
8	
9	CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
10	Jessica Campbell's unprofessional conduct, as described above, constitutes Gross
11	Neglect of Duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it
12	incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment), OAR 584-020-
13	0025(2)(e) (Using district lawful and reasonable rules and regulations); and OAR 584-
14	020-0040(4)(j) (Resignation from a contract in violation of ORS 342.553).
15	
16	The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS
17	342.175.
18	FINAL ORDER
19	The Commission hereby issues a Public Reprimand upon Jessica Campbell's Oregon
20	educator license.
