34	34 FINDINGS OF FA	CT	
35	35 1. Kyle Wroblewski has been licensed by the Comm	ission since January 28, 1998.	
36	Wroblewski's Standard Teaching License, with ar	endorsement in Standard Social	
37	37 Studies (020), was valid from March 19, 2014 thr	Studies (020), was valid from March 19, 2014 through April 1, 2019. During all	
38	38 relevant times Wroblewski was employed by the S	St. Helens School District (SHSD).	

2. On May 2, 2018, the Commission received a report from Oregon's Department of Human Services (DHS), alleging that Wroblewski was possibly involved in a sexual relationship with female student. Local law enforcement and SHSD were notified, and multiple investigations were conducted. Investigation determined that during the 2017-2018 school year, Wroblewski engaged in sexual conduct with a minor aged student. Wroblewski's sexual conduct with the minor student included intercourse and other acts of sexual conduct. Investigation determined there were additional teacher / student boundary violations and the use of marijuana with a minor. On or about July 9, 2018, Wroblewski was indicted on 32 counts of Sexual Abuse in the Second Degree (ORS 163.425). Wroblewski was also indicted on two counts of Official Misconduct in the First Degree (ORS 162.415).

3. On August 19, 2019, Wroblewski plead guilty to, and was convicted of five counts of Sexual Abuse in the Second Degree, ORS 163.425, a Class C Felony. Wroblewski was sentenced to serve all counts concurrently for a total of 30 months in prison with two years of post-prison supervision and required to register as a sex offender.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Kyle Wroblewski's criminal convictions as described in section three (3) above, constitute gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment); and OAR 584-020-0040(1) (The Commission will deny, revoke or deny the right to apply for a license or charter school registration to any applicant or educator who, has been convicted of any of the crimes listed in ORS 342.143, or the substantial equivalent of any of those crimes if convicted in another jurisdiction, or convicted of attempt to commit such crimes as defined in ORS 161.405), including ORS 163.425 –Sexual Abuse in the Second Degree. This conduct also constitutes gross unfitness in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(c); OAR 584-020-0040(5)(c) (Conviction of violating any federal, state, or local law. A conviction includes any final judgment of conviction by a court whether as the result of guilty plea, no contest plea or any other means); OAR 584-020-0040(5)(d) (Commission of an act listed in OAR 584-020-0040(1); and OAR 584-020-0040(5)(e) (Admission of or engaging in acts constituting criminal conduct, even in

1	the absence of a conviction).

3	Pursuant to ORS 342.175(3) and OAR 584-020-0040(1) the Teacher Standards	
4	and Practices Commission must revoke Wroblewski's license and / or Wroblewski's	
5	right to apply for a license based on Wroblewski's conviction of any of the crimes listed	
6	in ORS 342.143(3)(a), or the substantial equivalent of any of those crimes, or convicted	
7	of attempt to commit such crimes as defined in ORS 161.405.	
8		
9	Furthermore, the conduct underlying Wroblewski's convictions as described in	
10	section two (2) above, constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS	
11	342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (<i>Use</i>	
12	professional judgment); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(f) (Any sexual conduct with a student)	
13	as defined by OAR 584-020-0005(5); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(0) as it incorporates OAR	
14	584-020-0035(1)(c)(D) (Honoring appropriate adult boundaries with students in	
15	conduct and conversations at all times); and OAR 584-020-0035(3)(a)(Maintain the	
16	dignity of the profession by respecting and obeying the law, exemplifying personal	
17	integrity and honesty). Additionally, Wroblewski's criminal convictions and conduct	
18	related to his convictions constitute "gross unfitness" in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(c);	
19	OAR 584-020-0040(3)(c) and (d) as defined by OAR 584-020-0040 (5) (<i>Gross</i>	
20	unfitness is any conduct which renders an educator unqualified to perform his or her	
21	professional responsibilities).	
22		
23	The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon	
24	ORS 342.175.	
25	FINAL ORDER	
26	The Commission hereby revokes Kyle Wroblewski's Educator license and his	
27	right to apply for licensure.
