6            On or about May 15, 2019, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission)  
7   received a report from the Eugene School District, indicating possible misconduct on the part of  
8   Travis Tubbs (Tubbs).

9            After review of the matters alleged, Tubbs and the Commission agree that their respective  
10   interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts, the  
11   imposition of a ninety (90) day suspension of Tubbs' Oregon educator license, followed by a period  
12   of probation upon reinstatement of Tubbs' Oregon educator license.

13           This document sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the stipulated  
14   sanction to be imposed. Tubbs stipulates that there is sufficient evidence in the Commission's files  
15   and records to support the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below.

16           By signing below, Tubbs acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the following:  
17   (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing to contest the findings of fact,  
18   conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally waives all such rights and any  
19   rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of Facts and Final Order of Suspension and  
20   Probation (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this Stipulation and Final Order is a public document  
21   and disclosed to the public upon request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order  
22   is contingent upon and subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission  
23   does not approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Tubbs nor the  
24   Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and Final Order,  
25   and understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or duress, enters into this  
26   Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below;  
27   (vi) he states that no promises or representation has been made to induce him to sign this  
28   Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) he has consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation  
29   and Final Order and has been fully advised with regard to his rights thereto, or waives any and all  
30   rights to consult with an attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and  
31   issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below.
