## 1 BEFORE THE TEACHER STANDARDS AND PRACTICES COMMISSION 2 OF THE STATE OF OREGON 3 In the Matter of the STIPULATION OF FACTS AND 4 Teaching License of FINAL ORDER OF REPRIMAND 5 PHILIP RAYMOND JOANIS 6 7 On or about May 15, 2009, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission 8 (Commission) received a report from the Superintendent of the North Clackamas School 9 District stating that Philip Raymond Joanis (Joanis) consumed alcohol while supervising 10 a baseball team trip 11 After review of the matters alleged, Joanis and the Commission agree that their 12 respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to 13 certain facts and the imposition of a Public Reprimand on Joanis's Standard Teaching 14 License. 15 By signing below, Joanis acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to 16 the following: (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing to contest 17 the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally 18 waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of 19 Facts and Final Order of Reprimand (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this Stipulation 20 and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public upon request to the 21 Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and subject to 22 approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not approve and 23 adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Joanis nor the Commission are 24 bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and Final Order, and 25 understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or duress, enters into 26 this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of the Stipulated 27 Final Order below; (vi) he states that no promise or representation has been made to 28 induce him to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) he has consulted with an

attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully advised with

1 regard to his rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior 2 to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of the Stipulated 3 Final Order below. 4 STIPULATION OF FACTS 5 The Commission has licensed Joanis since September 20, 1979. Joanis currently holds a 6 Standard Teaching License, with endorsements in Standard Physical Education and 7 Basic Health Education, issued July 6, 2009 and valid until July 5, 2014. During all 8 relevant times Joanis was employed by the North Clackamas School District. 9 2. In the spring of the 2008/2009 school-year, Joanis acted as a chaperone on an out-of-10 state school trip. During the trip, and while responsible for student supervision, Joanis 11 consumed alcohol. Students reported that Joanis returned to the hotel along with other 12 coaches visibly intoxicated. 13 IT IS SO STIPULATED: 14  $\frac{7-12-11}{8-3-11}$ 15 16 17 18 19 Victoria Chamberlain, Executive Director 20 Teacher Standards and Practices Commission 21 CONCLUSION OF LAW 22 Philip Raymond Joanis consumed alcohol wile responsible for student supervision 23 during an out of town trip. This conduct constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 24 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (Use 25 professional judgment), and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(g) (Appearing on duty or at any district-26 sponsored activity while under the influence of alcohol or any controlled substance). 27 111 28 111 29 111
