9	On January 27, 2010, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission)
10	issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to Julia Ann Paige (Paige) in which the Commission
11	charged her with conviction of a crime listed in ORS 342.143(3). The Notice was sent via U.S.
12	First Class Mail and U.S. Certified Mail Receipt 7008 1410 0002 1925 4522 to the address on
13	file with the Commission. The U.S. Postal Service delivered two notices to Paige, the first on
14	January 29, 2010, and the second on February 2, 2010, in an attempt to deliver this certified
15	mail, before returning the certified mail receipt to the Commission on February 13, 2010. The
16	first class mail was not returned to the Commission. The Notice of Opportunity of Hearing,
17	dated January 27, 2010, and signed by Victoria Chamberlain, Executive Director, stated:
18 19 20 21 22 23	"If a request for hearing is not received within this 21 day period, your right to a hearing shall be considered waived unless your failure to request a hearing was beyond your reasonable control. If you do not request a hearing or if you fail to appear at a hearing, the Commission will adopt an order of default which may include the revocation or suspension of your license or other discipline."
24	Ms. Paige did not request a hearing. The Commission, therefore, finds Ms. Paige to be in
25	default and enters the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and order, based on the files
26	and records of the Commission concerning this matter.
27	FINDINGS OF FACT
28	1. On or about February 9, 2009, Ms. Paige, based on her February 6, 2009, guilty plea,
29	was convicted in the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for the County of Lane of
30	Delivery of Less than Five Grams of Marijuana.

1 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW** 2 Julia Ann Paige's conviction for Delivery of Less than Five Grams of Marijuana is a 3 conviction requiring revocation of her license pursuant to ORS 342.175(2); ORS 342.143(3)(A); 4 and constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-5 0040(1)(ww); and ORS 475.860 (Unlawful delivery of marijuana). 6 7 **FINAL ORDER** 8 The Commission hereby revokes Julia Ann Paige's right to apply for a teaching license. 9 IT IS SO ORDERED THIS day of May, 2010. 10 TEACHER STANDARDS AND PRACTICES COMMISSION 11 12 13 14 Victoria Chamberlain, Executive Director 15 16 17 18 19 NOTICE OF APPEAL OR RIGHTS 20 21 YOU ARE ENTITLED TO JUDICIAL REVIEW OF THIS ORDER.
