On or about December 14, 2006, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission) received a report from Don Alexander, Superintendent, Prospect School District, indicating that James Marshall Drago (Drago) used physical force against a student.

Mr. Drago fully cooperated with the Commission's investigation. After review of the matters alleged, Mr. Drago and the Commission agree that their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts and the imposition of a Public Reprimand.

This document sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the stipulated sanction to be imposed. Mr. Drago stipulates that there is sufficient evidence in the Commission's files and records to support the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below.

By signing below, Mr. Drago acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the following: (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing to contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of Facts and Final Order of Reprimand (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public upon request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Mr. Drago nor the Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) he states that no promises or representation has been made to induce him to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) he has consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully advised with

regard to his rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below.

STIPULATION OF FACTS

- 1. The Commission has licensed James Marshall Drago since November 9, 1990. Mr. Drago currently holds a Basic Teaching License valid March 31, 2006, through March 30, 2009, with a Basic Elementary endorsement.
- 2. Mr. Drago explained to the Commission that he often engaged in physical games with students including playful wrestling. On October 16, 2006 a student attempted to engage in physical play with Mr. Drago by placing him in a wrestling hold and challenging Mr. Drago to get out of the hold if possible. Mr. Drago responded by escaping the student's hold and placing the student on the floor. Although there is no evidence that Mr. Drago intended to inflict pain or harm, the student reported that he experienced pain from this incident.
- The Commission has received no prior reports or complaints concerning Mr. Drago in his nearly 17 years of being a licensed educator.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

James Marshall Drago violated OAR 584-020-0040(4)(d) when he used unreasonable physical force against a student. This misconduct constitutes Gross Neglect of Duty. The Commission has authority to impose discipline in this matter under ORS 342.120 through 342.430 and OAR Chapter 584.
