He further understands 13 that the probation will be subject to specific conditions. 14 STIPULATED FACTS 15 Mr. Kaltwasser and the Commission stipulate as follows: 16 Mr. Kaltwasser holds a standard teaching license with endorsements in standard 1. 17 biology and standard integrated science. 4 5	beginning the program. The program trainer will provide the Commission with a report of
6	successful program completion.
7	 Mr. Kaltwasser shall comply with all TSPC standards under OAR 584, Division 20.
8	3. Mr. Kaltwasser shall provided to the Commission such information as the
9	Commission requests to verify that he has complied with the conditions of probation, including a
10	statement from his employing school district, if any, that he has complied with the standards of
10	competent and ethical performance of educators under OAR 584, Division 20.
12	Violations of the terms of this probation may constitute an independent basis for the
13	Commission to impose discipline, up to and including revocation of Mr. Kaltwasser's Oregon
14	Teaching License, and subject to Mr. Kaltwasser's right to a hearing on the issue of whether he
15	violated probation.
