



1 Jerry M. Allen enters into this Stipulation of Facts with knowledge that the

ULTIMATE FINDINGS OF FACT

Jerry M. Allen was convicted in December 1996 on misdemeanor charges of Assault in the Fourth Degree and Harassment and is on probation until December 31, 1998.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


Under ORS 342.143 and OAR 584, Division 20 require educators to be law-abiding citizens.

ORDER

The Commission confirms issuance of a Teaching License to Jerry M. Allen for employment in Portland Public Schools. Mr. Allen shall be on probation from September 10, 1998 to September 10, 2000. During this period of probation, Mr. Allen shall conduct himself as a law-abiding citizen.


