Ms. Freed-Elefant requested a hearing to contest the allegations 9 in the notice. After review of the matters alleged, the parties have agreed that their respective 10 interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts and the 11 suspension of Ms. Freed-Elefant's license, followed by a period of probation. 12 In entering into this stipulation, Ms. Freed-Elefant waives her right to a hearing and 13 understands that the Commission will suspend her teaching license for a period of six months. 14 This stipulation and order are contingent on approval by the full Commission. If the 15 Commission does not approve this stipulation and proposed order, it is understood that any 16 waiver of rights by Ms. Freed-Elefant is therefore revoked. It is further understood that the 17 statements contained in this stipulation may not be used by either the Commission or Ms. Freed-18 Elefant for any reason if the Commission fails to approve the stipulation and proposed order. 19 STIPULATED FACTS 20 Ms. Freed-Elefant and the Commission stipulate as follows: 21 Ms. Freed-Elefant holds a Standard Teaching License and has been licensed in 1. 22 Oregon since 1977. 23



2		Valley High School in the Corvallis School District.
3	3.	In June 1998, Ms Freed-Elefant acted as chaperone to a group of high school
4		students on a district-sanctioned trip to Japan.
5	4.	During the trip, Ms. Freed-Elefant gave inappropriate and sexually suggestive
6		gifts to RH, a male high school student. The gifts were a set of "dirty dice" and a
7		Harley-Davidson calendar that featured scantily-clad women. Ms. Freed-Elefant
8		contends that she had parental permission to provide the calendar.
9	5.	During the trip, Ms. Freed-Elefant contacted RH by telephone on the evening of
10		June 23, 1998. At that time, Ms. Freed-Elefant made comments that were
11		inappropriate and reasonably perceived by RH as sexually suggestive and overly
12		personal. Ms. Freed-Elefant denies that she intended these comments as sexually
13		suggestive.
14	6.	On June 24, 1998, Ms. Freed-Elefant wrote and delivered a poem to RH. The
15		poem was inappropriate and reasonably perceived by RH to be a sexual advance.
16		Ms. Freed-Elefant denies that she intended that poem as a sexual advance.
