On or about August 14, 2002, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission

(Commission) received a report from Kathryn Baker, Superintendent, Salem-Keizer

Public Schools indicating that Pamela Jean Gartner (Gartner) was arrested and charged

with Assault IV in connection with an incident of domestic violence.

Ms. Gartner fully cooperated with the Commission's investigation. After review of the facts in this matter, Ms. Gartner and the Executive Director agree that their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts, a reprimand followed by a probation of one (1) year.

This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the sanction to be imposed. Ms. Gartner stipulates that there are sufficient facts contained in the Commission's files and records to support the findings of fact and conclusions of law set forth below. In entering into this stipulation, Ms. Gartner waives the right to a hearing to contest the findings of fact, conclusion of law and order set forth below.

Ms. Gartner understands that the Commission will impose a one (1) year probation with specific conditions.

This stipulation is contingent upon approval and adoption of the Order by the Commission. If the Commission does not adopt this Order, neither Ms. Gartner nor the Commission are bound by these Stipulations and Ms. Gartner retains all rights to a hearing on the allegations.
