CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


ORS 342.553 requires the suspension of a license for the balance of the school year for failure to provide 60 days' notice prior to resignation. If the charge of the contract violation is proven, and justification for the contract violation is not satisfactory, the Commission is required to suspend the license for the remainder of the school year. The Commission's decision is final.

ORDER

The Commission suspends the Oregon Teaching License #307391, issued to Mark German, for violation of contract by resignation without providing 60 days' written notice.


