On or about January 29, 2002, the Teacher Standards and Practices

Commission (Commission) issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to Sheryl Lee

Knowlton (Knowlton) in which the Commission proposed to take disciplinary action

against her under ORS 342.175 through ORS 342.190.

After review of the matters alleged, Ms. Knowiton and the Commission agree that their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts, the imposition of a written reprimand and imposition of terms of probation. This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the sanction to be imposed. In entering into this stipulation, Ms. Knowlton waives the right to a hearing to contest the findings of fact, conclusion of law and order set forth below.

10	Performance under Chapter OAR 584, Division 020 and adhere to all safety policies of		
11	any employing district.		
12	Violation of the terms of this probation may constitute an Independent basis for		
3	the Commission to Impose discipline, up to and including revocation of Ms. Knowiton's		
14	teaching license subject to Ms. Knowiton's right to a hearing on the issue of whether		
15	she violated probation.
