



1 Mr. Batenhorst enters into this Stipulation of Facts with knowledge that The Teachers
2 Standards and Practices commission will revoke his Oregon teaching license. This stipulation is
3 contingent on approval and adoption of the order by the Commission. If the Commission does
4 not adopt this order, neither Mr. Batenhorst nor the Commissioner bound by these stipulations
5 and he retains all rights to a hearing on the allegations.

13 **ULTIMATE FINDINGS OF FACT**

14 Leo David Batenhorst violated these standards of competent and ethical performance for
15 Oregon educators by altering the authorization code on his teaching license and by presenting
16 that altered license by facsimile to his employer to falsely indicate his licensure for high school
17 assignments.

18 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

19 Under ORS 342.175 and OAR 584, Division 020, false statements and forged official
20 documents are grounds for a findings of gross neglect of duty.

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1 **ORDER**

2 The Commission revokes the Oregon teaching license of Leo David Batenhorst effective
3 January 10, 2000, for falsification of documents related to his employment as an educator.
