BEFORE THE TEACHIS STANDARDS AND PRACTICES COMMISSIGNATION & 1 Practices Commission 2 OF THE STATE OF OREGON 3 In the Matter of the STIPULATION OF FACTS AND 4 5 6 **Educator License of**) FINAL ORDER OF PUBLIC **GARY JACKMAN**) REPRIMAND AND PROBATION 7 8 On April 11, 2018, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission 9 (Commission) received a report from the Department of Human Services (DHS) 10 indicating possible professional misconduct on the part of licensed educator, Gary 11 Jackman (Jackman). 12 After review of the matters alleged, Jackman and the Commission agree that their 13 respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to 14 certain facts, the imposition of a Public Reprimand, and a period of probation. 15 This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the 16 sanction to be imposed. Jackman stipulates that there are sufficient facts contained in 17 the Commission's files and records to support the findings of fact and conclusions of law 18 set forth below. In entering into this stipulation, Jackman waives the right to a hearing 19 to contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law and order set forth below. 20 By signing below, Jackman acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to 21 the following: (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing to contest 22 the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally 23 waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of 24 Facts and Final Order of Public Reprimand and Probation (Stipulation and Final Order); 25 (ii) this Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public 26 upon request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent 27 upon and subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does 28 not approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Jackman nor the 29 Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and 30 Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or 31 duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of 32 the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) he states that no promise or representation has 33 been made to induce him to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) he has 34 consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully 35 advised with regard to his rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an

attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below.

STIPULATION OF FACTS

- 1. The Commission has licensed Jackman since April 11, 1983. Jackman holds a Substitute Teaching License, with an endorsement in Substitute Any Specialty (PP-12), valid from October 20, 2015, through October 19, 2018. During all relevant times, Jackman was employed by the EMS Sub-desk, providing substitute services for the Reynolds School District (RSD).
- 2. On April 11, 2018, the Commission received a report from the Department of Human Services (DHS) indicating Jackman may have committed an act of gross neglect of duty and/or gross unfitness. Specifically, unprofessional interactions with coworkers and other employees.
- 3. Investigation determined that on or about April 9, 2018, while providing long term substitute teaching services, Jackman became irritated due in part to difficult environmental working conditions and a challenging classroom assignment (SPED Functional Life Skills). In Jackman's own words he "Became really pissed off" and on more than one occasion, used inappropriate language in front of several staff members and coworkers. Staff described Jackman as volatile and angry. At one point, Jackman kicked a blue gym mat that was blocking his way, adding to the discomfort of Jackman's coworkers. Investigation determined that Jackman's inappropriate conduct was not in the presence of students. Jackman's conduct was reviewed by EMS who determined to remove Jackman from the substitute list until further notice.

1 **CONCLUSION OF LAW** 2 The conduct described above constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 3 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(1) 4 (Recognize the worth and dignity of all persons and respect for each individual), OAR 5 584-020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment), OAR 584-020-0030(2)(a) (Willingness 6 to be flexible in cooperatively working with others), and OAR 584-020-0030(2)(b) (Skill 7 in communicating with administrators, students, staff, parents, and other patrons). 8 9 The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon 10 ORS 342.175. 11 12 **ORDER** 13 The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and 14 conclusions of law, and based thereon, imposes a Public Reprimand on Gary Jackman's 15 Oregon educator license. 16 Furthermore, the Commission imposes a period of six (6) months of probation 17 upon Jackman's licensure to commence from the date this order is signed by the 18 Commission and subject to the following conditions: 19 20 Jackman shall comply with the Standards for Competent and Ethical 21 Performance of Oregon Educators under Oregon Administrative Rules Chapter 22 584, Division 020. 23 2.
