7 In May 1998, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission  
8 (Commission) received a complaint and commenced an investigation  
9 concerning Jerry Wayne Jenson, (Mr. Jenson). Subsequently  
10 Mr. Jenson and the Commission agreed to enter a stipulation in  
11 which Mr. Jenson surrenders his Oregon teaching license and  
12 stipulates to certain matters as set forth below.

13 Mr. Jenson denies that he engaged in any inappropriate  
14 activity. However, Mr. Jenson has now retired from the teaching  
15 profession and chooses to enter into this stipulation rather than  
16 undergoing the expense and pressure of a contested case hearing.  
17 In entering into this stipulation, Mr. Jenson acknowledges that  
18 he is waiving his right to a hearing before a panel of the  
19 commission. Although Mr. Jenson denies misconduct, he stipulates  
20 that there is substantial evidence in the records of the  
21 Commission for the Commission to make the findings set forth  
22 below.

23 FINDINGS OF FACTS

24 1. In February 1997, Jenson was employed as an elementary  
25 teacher in the Three Rivers School District.





1           2.    On about February 11, 1997, Jenson allegedly engaged in  
2 inappropriate conduct by allegedly striking a student in his  
3 classroom on the head with a plastic case. Pursuant to  
4 negotiations between Mr. Jenson and the District Attorney,  
5 criminal charges were subsequently dismissed based upon Jenson's  
6 intention to retire from teaching and surrender his license.



15 CONCLUSION OF LAW


16 The above conduct constitutes gross neglect of duty under
