



1 3. On June 14, 2002, Oregon City Public Schools reported that during the 2001-2002  
2 school year, Ms. Danielson forged over thirty (30) signatures on twenty-two (22) separate  
3 documents. These documents included referral forms, IEP eligibility statements and placement  
4 determination forms.

5 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

6 The above conduct constitutes Gross Neglect of Duty in violation of OAR 584-020-  
7 0040(4)(o) and 584-020-0040(4)(c). This conduct constitutes Gross Neglect of Duty. The  
8 Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS 342.175.

9 **ORDER**

10 The Commission hereby revokes the Oregon Standard Teaching License issued to  
11 Sandra Jean Danielson.
