1 BEFORE THE TEACHIS STANDARDS AND PRACTICES COMMISSION 2 OF THE STATE OF OREGON 3 In the Matter of the) STIPULATION OF FACTS AND 4 **Educator License of**) FINAL ORDER OF REPRIMAND 5) JOSEPH RONALD DURAN AND PROBATION 6 7 On or about November 12, 2015, the Teacher Standards and Practices 8 Commission (Commission) received a district report indicating possible professional 9 misconduct on the part of licensed educator, Joseph Ronald Duran (Duran). 10 After review of the matters alleged, Duran and the Commission agree that their 11 respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to 12 certain facts, the imposition of a Public Reprimand, and a period of probation. 13 This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the 14 sanction to be imposed. Duran stipulates that there are sufficient facts contained in the 15 Commission's files and records to support the findings of fact and conclusions of law set 16 forth below. In entering into this stipulation, Duran waives the right to a hearing to 17 contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law and order set forth below. 18 By signing below, Duran acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the 19 following: (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing to contest the 20 findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally 21 waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of 22 Facts and Final Order of Reprimand and Probation (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) 23 this Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public upon 24 request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and 25 subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not 26 approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Duran nor the 27 Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and 28 Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or 29 duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of 30 the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) he states that no promise or representation has 31 been made to induce him to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) he has 32 consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully 33 advised with regard to his rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an 34 attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of

the Stipulated Final Order below.

1 STIPULATION OF FACTS 2 1. The Commission has licensed Duran since July 2000. Duran's Professional 3 Teaching License, with an endorsement in Social Studies (PK-12), is valid August 4 29, 2015, through August 28, 2020. During all relevant times, Duran was 5 employed by the Portland Public School District. 6 2. On November 12, 2015, the Commission received a school district report alleging 7 that based on its investigation of complaints from two female students, Duran 8 displayed inappropriate teacher / student boundaries, including: 9 Sharing/discussing personal information with students, including asking 10 students about their personal relationships; 11 Playing music with sexually suggestive lyrics after class when a student 12 was present; 13 Sending Facebook friend requests to students; 14 Interacting with students in a manner and making overly personal 15 comments that made students feel uncomfortable. 16 17 3. Records indicate that, Duran had previously received a written reprimand and 18 warning; that in part, directed Duran to maintain appropriate professional 19 boundaries and consult with the District EAP. 20 4. On August 3, 2016, Duran resigned his employment with Portland Public 21 Schools. 22 5. On November 21, 2016, the Commission received confirmation that Duran had 23 voluntarily completed five and one half hours of boundaries training in one-to-24 one sessions. 1 CONCLUSION OF LAW 2 The conduct described above constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS 3 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (Use 4 professional judgment), OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e) (Using district lawful and reasonable 5 rules and regulations), OAR 584-020-0030(2)(b) (Skill in communicating with 6 administrators, students, staff, parents, and other patrons); and OAR 584-020-7 0040(4)(0) as it incorporates, OAR 584-020-0035(1)(c)(D) (Honoring appropriate adult 8 boundaries with students in conduct and conversations at all times). 9 10 The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon 11 ORS 342.175. 12 13 **ORDER** 14 The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and 15 conclusions of law, and based thereon, imposes a Public Reprimand on Joseph Ronald 16 Duran's Oregon educator licenses. 17 Furthermore, the Commission imposes a period of three (3) years of probation 18 upon Duran's licensure to commence from the date this order is signed by the 19 Commission and subject to the following conditions: 20 1. Duran shall comply with the Standards for Competent and Ethical Performance 21 of Oregon Educators under Oregon Administrative Rules Chapter 584, Division 22 020. 23 day of April. 2018.
