


1 relationship by the girl's parents who explained that they had discussed the situation with the

15 **CONCLUSION OF LAW**

16 Michael Linn Cahill failed to make a mandatory report of child abuse pursuant to ORS
17 419B.010. This misconduct constitutes Gross Neglect of Duty in violation OAR 584-020-
18 0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) and 584-020-0025(3)(a). The
19 Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS 342.175.

20 **ORDER**

21 The Commission hereby adopts the above findings of fact and imposes a Public
22 Reprimand upon the Licensure of Michael Linn Cahill. This Order shall serve as the Public
23 Reprimand.
