6	On or about June 30, 2003, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission
7	(Commission) received a report from Larry Horton, Superintendent, Sweet Home
8	School District, indicating that Kevin Wayne Spinney (Spinney) used his school
9	computer to access sexually explicit material on the Internet.
10	After review of the matters alleged, Mr. Spinney and the Commission agree that
11	their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a
12	stipulation to certain facts and the imposition of a ninety (90) day suspension of
13	licensure followed by two (2) year period of probation upon reinstatement of Licensure.
14	This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the
15	sanction to be imposed. Mr. Spinney stipulates that there are sufficient facts contained
16	in the Commission's files and records to support the findings of fact and conclusions of
17	law set forth below. In entering into this stipulation, Mr. Spinney waives the right to a
18	hearing to contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law and order set forth below.
19	Mr. Spinney understands that the probation will be subject to specific conditions.
20	This stipulation is contingent upon approval and adoption of the Order by the
21	Commission. If the Commission does not adopt this Order, neither Mr. Spinney nor the
22	Commission are bound by these Stipulations and Mr. Spinney retains all rights to a

hearing on the allegations.

STIPULATION OF FACTS 1. Mr. Spinney holds an Initial Teaching License issued September 21, 2001, 3 valid through April 5, 2005, with a Health Education Endorsement. 4 2. Mr. Spinney began employment with the Sweet Home School District as a 5 Health/Physical Education Teacher at Sweet Home High School in August of 2001. On 6 March 7, 2003, Mr. Spinney resigned his teaching position in lieu of non-renewal 7 effective June 13, 2003. 8 3. A District-owned computer with Internet access was present in Mr. Spinney's 9 classroom for his use in connection with his assigned responsibilities. The District has a 10 clearly defined, acceptable use policy. The District's policy prohibits the use or 11 attempted use of equipment for Internet access of sexually explicit materials. 4. Mr. Spinney used his classroom computer on June 18, 23 and 24, 2003, to 12 access sexually explicit materials through the District's Internet connection in violation of 14 District policy regarding Internet use. 15 IT IS SO STIPULATED: 4/16/04 Date 3-17-04 16 17 18 19 Victoria Chamberlain, Executive Director 20 Teacher Standards and Practices Commission 111 21 22 111

ULTIMATE FINDING OF FACT

Kevin Wayne Spinney used the computer equipment owned by his employer,
Sweet Home School District, located on school premises, to access sexually explicit
materials. Mr. Spinney was fully aware that accessing such materials at the workplace
using a District owned computer was inappropriate and in violation of District policy.
CONCLUSION OF LAW
Kevin Wayne Spinney's inappropriate use of a District computer constitutes
Gross Neglect of Duty in violation of OAR 584-020-0040(4)(q). The Commission's
authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS 342.175.

1	ORDER
2	Kevin Wayne Spinney's Initial Teaching License is suspended for a period of
3	ninety (90) days effective on May 7, 2004. At the end of this suspension period,
4	Mr. Spinney's Initial Teaching License will be reinstated upon:
5	1. Submission of a complete application and fees pursuant to OAR 584-050-
6	0015(3); and
7	2. Submission of documentation that he has undergone an evaluation by a
8	psychotherapist or medical professional acceptable to the Commission, and the

2. Submission of documentation that he has undergone an evaluation by a psychotherapist or medical professional acceptable to the Commission, and the evaluator submits a written report to the Commission attesting (a) Mr. Spinney is fit to work with children and teenagers, and (b) there is a high probability he will not use school district equipment to access sexually explicit materials or engage in similar inappropriate behavior. Any costs associated with the assessment or treatment will be the responsibility of Mr. Spinney.

Upon the reinstatement of licensure, Mr. Spinney shall be placed on probation by the Commission for a period of two (2) years, subject to the following conditions:

- Mr. Spinney shall substantially comply with any treatment or counseling as recommended by the individual who completed the evaluation described above.
 Mr. Spinney shall authorize and sign any consent forms as necessary for the treatment provider or counselor to furnish records to or discuss Mr. Spinney's treatment with the Commission.
- 2. Mr. Spinney shall comply with all Standards for Competent and Ethical Performance of Oregon Educators under Oregon Administrative Rules, Chapter 584, Division 020.

ί.	5. Wr. Spinney shall provide information as requested by the Commission to
2	verify that he has complied with the conditions of probation, including a statement from
3	a future employing district that he has complied with the Standards for Competent and
4	Ethical Performance of Oregon Educators.
5	Violation of the terms of this probation may constitute an independent basis for
6	the Commission to impose discipline, up to and including revocation of Mr. Spinney's
7	teaching license subject to Mr. Spinney's right to a hearing on the issue of whether he
8	violated probation.
9	IT IS SO ORDERED this day of May, 2004.
