BEFORE THE TEACHER STANDARDS AND PRACTICES COMMISSION 1 OF THE STATE OF OREGON 2 STIPULATION OF FACTS 3 In the Matter of the FINAL ORDER OF 4 Teaching License of SUSPENSION 5 Bart Richard Rothenberger 6 On or about June 21, 2005, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission 7 (Commission) received a report from W. Rolla Webber, Superintendent, Marcola School District, 8 indicating that Bart Richard Rothenberger (Rothenberger) behaved inappropriately around 9 students and made inappropriate comments to students. 10 After review of the matters alleged, Mr. Rothenberger and the Commission agree that 11 their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to 12 certain facts and the imposition of a suspension and probation. 13 By signing below, Mr. Rothenberger acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees 14 to the following: (I) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing to contest the 15 findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally waives all 16 such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of Facts, Order of 17 Suspension and Probation (Stipulation and Final Order): (ii) this Stipulation and Final Order is a 18 public document and disclosed to the public upon request by the Commission; (iii) this 19 Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and subject to approval and adoption by the 20 Commission. If the Commission does not approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, 21 then neither Mr. Rothenberger nor the Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has 22 fully read this Stipulation and Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily, 23 without any force or duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to 24 issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) he states that no promises or 25 representation has been made to induce him to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) he 26 has consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully 27 advised with regard to his rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney 28

STIPULATION OF FACTS

- The Commission has licensed Mr. Rothenberger since May 3, 2004. Mr. Rothenberger holds an Initial I Teaching License, with endorsements in Health Education HS/ML, Multiple Subjects, Middle Level and Physical Education ML/HS valid until June 27, 2011.
 - Bart Rothenberger began work for the Marcola School District In the 2000-2001 school
 year as a basketball coach. For the following two years, Rothenberger worked as a
 basketball coach, custodian and bus driver.
 - 3. In 2003, Rothenberger obtained an emergency teaching license and was hired to teach part-time and to serve as Athletic Director part-time. He was assigned to teach PE and health. From 2003 to 2007, Rothenberger worked for the Marcola School District in a licensed position. His duties included teaching, coaching, advising the student council, and serving as Athletic Director.
 - 4. In December, 2004, complaints were filed with the Marcola administration against Rothenberger by students and parents. The complaints concerned use of inappropriate sexual banter and foul language with students and allowing student conversations to continue which Rothenberger should have stopped. Rothenberger admitted to engaging in some sexual banter and foul language with students, to discussing sexual topics, to using swear words on the bus, and to failing to enforce appropriate standards of behavior for himself and for some of his students.
 - 5. Rothenberger was placed on a plan of assistance from March 2005 to June 2007 as a result of the complaints. The plan required Rothenberger to conduct himself in a professional manner and demonstrate a commitment to recognizing the dignity and worth of all persons. Rothenberger successfully completed the plan of assistance.
