On or about December 10, 2007, Mr. Jackson applied to the Commission for registration as a charter school administrator. On May 15, 2008, the Commission issued a Notice of Denial of Charter School Registration and Opportunity for Hearing on the basis of ORS 342.143(2) and OAR 584-020-0040(3)(b). Mr. Jackson requested a hearing.

The Commission and Mr. Jackson agree that their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulated order denying Mr. Jackson's application for charter school Administrator Registration.

By signing below, Mr. Jackson acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the following: (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice of charges and a hearing to contest the allegations, and fully and finally waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulated Final Order; (ii) this Stipulated Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public upon request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulated Final Order is contingent upon and subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not approve and adopt this Stipulated Final Order, then neither Mr. Jackson nor the Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily enters into this Stipulated Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) he has advised of his right to counsel and has elected to proceed without counsel and waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior to entering into this Stipulated Final Order and issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below.

1. Mr. Jackson applied for a Charter School Administrator Registration on December 10, 2007. Mr. Jackson has been licensed as an attorney in Oregon since 1976.

2. In 1986, Mr. Jackson was admonished by the Oregon State Bar for neglect of a legal matter and failure to cooperate with disciplinary counsel. Mr. Jackson did not disclose or provide a detailed explanation of this discipline in his application to the Commission.

3. In 1996, Mr. Jackson was reprimanded by the Oregon State Bar for neglect of a legal matter. Mr. Jackson did not disclose or provide a detailed explanation of this discipline in his application to the Commission.

4. In 1999, Mr. Jackson was suspended from the practice of law for 30 days for failing to maintain client records and failing to account for client funds.

5. In 2008, Mr. Jackson was suspended from the practice of Law for 180 days for neglect of a legal matter, making a misrepresentation to a tribunal, conduct prejudicial to the administration of justice, and engaging in conduct involving misrepresentation. Mr. Jackson has appealed the matter to the Oregon Supreme Court.

6. During the 2006-2007 school year, Mr. Jackson claimed that unregistered persons teaching at Sand Ridge Charter School were not required to be registered with the Commission.
